60 day closure of application for Nationals or Island Championship.

ANY financial member club will have 60 clear days after the previous Nationals or Island Championship event to apply (to the Executive Officer) for the NEXT Nationals or Island Championship.

Each application will be held till the end of the 60 day period before the decision process is started.

At this point the Section Director for that discipline will make his/her recommendation on the club of choice and why, this decision will go to the Executive Officer and their decision and recommendations will go to Council for a final decision.

Council will make the decision on the host club within 2 weeks of the 60 day closure.

Any unsuccessful applicant will be contacted by the PNZ Executive Officer on the decision and reasons why one applicant (if any) was turned down.

Council may decide to award Championship events to one club for more than one consecutive year, if this is the case, any club applying for the same event on one of these consecutive years will be informed of the Council decision.

National's medals-limits per divisions: (From 01/01/2012)

Divisions or classes with 5 or less competitors- Gold Medal only

Divisions or classes with 6 or more competitors- Gold, Silver and Bronze

Junior Divisions have no number restrictions and will be awarded Gold, Silver and Bronze providing 3 shooters compete in each of the junior categories. (Alterations to the above limits will be at the discretion of the Section Director in consultation with the PNZ XO).

Cut off date for entries must be at least 4 weeks before the event, (List of medals to be confirmed latest, 3 weeks out from the first day of the match)

Prizes for merit (grades)

If there is merit being recognised IE: 1-3 in a grade, then the host club must provide a medal, trophy or certificate.

(These medals can be purchased by the club at cost from PNZ, contact the XO for more details)

It is expectation that clubs hosting an Island or National event charge juniors half the full match fee. If the host club does not wish to do this, then this reason needs to be on the entry form. (Requirement starts January 2013)

Any questions about this form should be directed to the PNZ XO.

Entry forms

The match entry form should be sent to the PNZ XO as soon as possible after the match approval has been given.
