60 day closure of application for Nationals or Island Championship.

ANY financial member club will have 60 clear days after the previous Nationals or Island Championship event to apply (to the Executive Officer) for the NEXT Nationals or Island Championship.

Each application will be held till the end of the 60 day period before the decision process is started.

At this point the Section Director for that discipline will make his/her recommendation on the club of choice and why, this decision will go to the Executive Officer and their decision and recommendations will go to Council for a final decision.

Council will make the decision on the host club within 2 weeks of the 60 day closure.

Any unsuccessful applicant will be contacted by the PNZ Executive Officer on the decision and reasons why one applicant (if any) was turned down. Council may decide to award Championship events to one club for more than one consecutive year, if this is the case, any club applying for the same event on one of these consecutive years will be informed of the Council decision.

2. Island and Regional events must have their medals paid for once the application has been approved.
(National Events have PNZ Included in the engraving)

A GUIDE TO SETTING ENTRY FEES

While the amount you wish to charge for application is up to your club, newer innovations like "Steel Master" and the side events like .22 rifle add additional cost (and revenue) for the match organisers.

The side event, .22 Rifle are just that, additional events that can be added to encourage not only experienced shooters but Juniors and Tyro's who have not shot any match before.

Tyro's do not even have to be holster or B endorsement qualified as the events are started by aiming at a "Flag" or "Post" in the ground, when the buzzer goes off.

Fees for these matches should be around \$10 each, we would suggest. A late fee box has been added to encourage shooters to get their entries in fast and again this is at the clubs discretion.

The match rules are before council and will be updated soon but use the current version for all events.

Speed Shooting Divisions as at December 2010

Open Auto, Open Revolver (All open class IPSC, NRA style pistols, comps ports & optics are specifically allowed)

Production Division (Production IPSC or USPSA class)

Iron Sight Auto (Any "Iron" sight Auto Pistol. No Comps, Ports or Optics)

Iron Sight Revolver (Any "Iron" sight Revolver. No Comps, Ports or Optics)

Single Action Revolver (CAS)

Open .22 Pistol

Iron Sight .22 Pistol (No Comps, Ports or Optics)

.22 L/R Rifle Division (Match using .22 L/R Rifle on the same courses of fire as used by pistol)

In addition to the above divisions, shooters may also choose the following categories to shoot in if applicable.

Ladies

Senior (the day of the 50th birthday to the day of the 60th birthday inclusive)

Super Senior (the day after the 60th birthday).

Junior 12-18 (up to the 18th birthday inclusive)

Steel Master A choice of a 1 x .22 1 x Iron Sight (Centerfire) and 1 x Open (Centerfire) all to be shot for score in the match
(Islands and Regional shoots optional)

All of the above divisions will need be offered at the National Championships.

Island and regional events can choose to offer all the events above or a selection but the following should be compulsory at the Island Champs.

Open and I/S Auto, Production Division, Open & I/S Revolver, Single Action Revolver (CAS)

Ladies Senior Super Senior

National's medals-limits per divisions: (From 01/01/2012)

Divisions or classes with 5 or less competitors- Gold Medal only

Divisions or classes with 6 or more competitors- Gold, Silver and Bronze

Cutoff date for entries must be at least 3 weeks before the event (List of medals to be confirmed on this date)
