Northern Speed Challenge

To all those who love to shoot Speed here is an opportunity to head north, see some of our beautiful countryside and, of course, shoot some steel. Whether it is for fun or for some serious competition this may be the event for you.

This event is to be a warm up for the Speed Nationals which are fast approaching. So here is a chance to meet new friends and say hi to the old ones, as well as warm up your gun and get your eye in.

This is a new event. All are welcome to come and give it a blast regardless if you are new to the sport or if you want to see how you are shooting prior to the Nationals. We are hoping to make this an annual event.

All competitors may shoot in the five divisions listed on the entry form. There will be two trophies handed out to the overall best time in Female, Senior and Super Senior regardless of which division you shoot. The main trophy will be returned to WPC prior to the next shoot. The winner will retain the second smaller trophy. The top shooter in each category will also be presented with a Trophy and Medal. (The trophy will again be returned for the next shoot.) Medals will be awarded to each winner in their grade regardless which division they enter. There will also be certificates handed out to second and Third place getters in all categories.

There will be a side event held on both Saturday and Sunday if time permits. This will be a fun shoot and winner may take all. There will be some sponsored prizes up for grabs. It will be decided on your competition number being drawn out of a hat.

We will be shooting five of the Speed stages that are shoot at the New Zealand Nationals and two other stages.

The stages are: **Five to go, Smoke n Hope, Roundabout, Outer Limits, Accelerator,**
with **The Wedge and Pendulum** being shot as the extras.

There will be a barbecue lunch of sausages, onions and bread along with Mussels. Tea and coffee will be provided. Orange juice is provided by our local Anchor milk supplier however these will be limited so it will pay to bring your own water. We do have a Fizzy vending machine at the club so bring all your small change.

You will need a minimum of 25 rounds per stage, however bring plenty of ammo as you never know where your eye leads you on the day.

45ACP is the largest calibre allowed

Payment may be made by posting a cheque to the address on the entry form or payment can be made on the day.
