In order to be eligible to sit this course you **MUST** have completed your six month probationary period and completed the Basic Pistol Shooting Safety Programme and the test Also you must be the holder of a current "A" category firearms licence.

It is also recommended that you have some knowledge of the rules and regulations of Action Pistol, IPSC, CASS style shooting prior to undertaking this course.
