A GUIDE TO SETTING ENTRY FEES

While the amount you wish to charge for application is up to your club, newer innovations like "Multigun" and the side events like .22 pistol and rifle add additional cost (and revenue) for the match organisers.

Multigun entails the use of a second center fire pistol for score in the main match and should attract a smaller fee, around a third of the main match fee (Nationals \$60, so \$20). This will allow the club to cover all its costs and allow it make a bit more profit on the side.

The side events, .22 Pistol and Rifle are just that, additional events that can be added to encourage not only experienced shooters but Juniors and Tyro's who have not shot any match before.

Tyro's do not even have to be holster or B endorsement qualified as the events are started by aiming at a "Flag" or "Post" in the ground, when the buzzer goes off.

Fees for these matches should be around \$10 each, we would suggest. A late fee box has been added to encourage shooters to get their entries in fast and again this is at the clubs discretion.

The match rules are before council and will be updated soon but use the current version for all events.

Speed Shooting Divisions as at December 2009

Open Division (All open class IPSC, NRA style pistol)

Production Division (Production IPSC class)

Standard Division (Standard IPSC Class)

Iron Sight Revolver (Open sight IPSC class revolvers)

In addition to the above divisions, shooters may also choose the following classes to shoot in if applicable.

Senior Division 50-60 (the day of the 50th birthday to the day of the 60th birthday inclusive)

Super Senior Division 60 plus (the day after the 60th birthday).

The following cowboy divisions are inclusive of all Cowboy pistols of choice and recognise age ONLY

Cowboy Traditional 18-39 (on the day of the 18th birthday to the day of the 39th birthday inclusive)

Cowboy 49ers 39-50 (the day after the 39th birthday to the day of the 50th birthday inclusive)

Cowboy Senior 50-60 (the day after the 50th birthday to the day of the 60th birthday inclusive)

Cowboy Super Senior 60 plus (the day after the 60th birthday)

Junior 12-18 (up to the 18th birthday inclusive)

Open .22 L/R Division (Open to anyone)

Open .22 L/R Rifle Division (Match using .22 L/R Rifle on the same courses of fire as used by pistol)

Multigun A choice of a primary Pistol and a secondary pistol, both to be shot for score in the match (Both Centre fire)
(Islands and Regional shoots optional)

All of the above divisions will need be offered at the National Championships.

Island and regional events can choose to offer all the events above or a selection but the following should be compulsory at the Island Champs.

- Open Division Standard Division Production Division Iron Sight Revolver
- Ladies Senior Super Senior
