

NZ Pistol Team Selection Criteria

2009 Oceania Continental Grand Prix

28th November → 3th December 2009

Host: Sydney, Australia



Objective:

To select National Teams to compete in the 2009 Oceania Championships

The Oceania Continental Grand Prix team will be selected from a **series of ranking matches, open to all PNZ members. National A and B Squad members will not take automatic slots in the team BUT a MQS system will apply. One MQS score plus the compulsory Nationals score will need to be shot to be eligible for selection over the six Oceania ranking matches.**

MQS scores are:

50m Pistol	530
25m Rapid Fire Pistol	556
25m Centre Fire Pistol	561
25m Sport Pistol	556
25m Standard Pistol	551
10m Men's Air Pistol	561
10m Woman's Air Pistol	367
10m Men's Junior Air Pistol	530
10m Woman's Junior Air Pistol	353
25m Sport Junior Pistol	535

One athlete in each event will automatically receive selection based on victory at the 2009 NATIONALS .This automatic selection does not require a MQS score.

The remaining team members will then be selected from the 2009 Oceania ranking list. This will comprise three match scores, one has to be the compulsory Nationals. Any tie will be broken by ISSF rules at the final ranking match (Hawkes Bay June 09). One MQS score must be shot in these matches.

The PNZ selectors will rank the squad in November 2009 based on the current level of performance.

Using the two highest scores plus the compulsory Nationals from the designated matches listed below during the selection period will form the ranking list. (Nov 2008 – June 2009). The NZSF in conjunction with the National Association reserves the right to limit team size according to performance achieved during the Oceania ranking list matches.

As stated above the winners of the Nationals will automatically receive selection.

Information specific for Pistol NZ (Oceania 2009).

Selection Process:

The **PNZ ISSF Nationals winners are automatic** selections, other individuals have the ranking list with a total of three scores from the six matches. (Nationals score is compulsory and One MQS score is needed)

a/ The three highest ranked shooters **for each match** who have met the selection criteria will be selected as the New Zealand "A Team, should a "A" team be selected

b/ The next three highest ranked shooters **for each match** who have met the selection criteria will be selected as the New Zealand "B Team, should a "B" team be selected

Overseas based competitors:

Overseas based shooters who wish to contest selection may substitute events for ranking and MQS providing that the events are on equal or higher standard and that they are nominated prior to taking place. The PNZ Nationals are still compulsory and attendance is required.

Ratification of Selected Teams:

a/ The Selectors for the PNZ ISSF Oceania Team are the ISSF Section Director, the ISSF National Coach and the PNZ President. Selectors will "stand down" on selecting any team members that they the Selectors maybe eligible for.

b/ Teams will be confirmed at the conclusion of the Hawkes Bay match in Napier June 2009.

c/ Successful team members will be advised once teams have been ratified by PNZ council. The list of successful Team Members will also be sent to the NZSF

d/ PNZ council will reserve the right to approve the filling of vacant team positions, at the recommendation of the Selectors.

e/ All selected shooters must sign the Athlete's Agreement and any appeals are made to PSNZ.

Team manager:

A Team Manager *may* be appointed by PNZ council

Funding assistance:

a/ PNZ will fund the match entry fee for selected shooters for the Team in which they are selected, from the International Competition Fund as follows:

- 100% subsidy for shooters selected in the A Team
- 75% subsidy for shooters selected in the B Team
- 100% subsidy for the Junior Teams

To Be Confirmed

b/ A NZ Pistol Team uniform *may* be created and subsidized by the PNZ ISSF Section. The extent of the subsidy will be determined by funds available to the ISSF Section at the time the uniform is purchased.

c/ Accommodation and transport for the Oceania Championships will be confirmed for the Oceania Championships at the earliest possible opportunity
