

NZ Pistol Team Selection Criteria 2010 CSF Championships

February 2010

Host: Delhi, India



Objective:

To select National Teams to compete in the 2010 Commonwealth Shooting Federation Championships

Number of teams:

Up to 3 shooters for the following matches

- 50m Pistol
- 25m Rapid Fire Pistol
- 25m Centre Fire Pistol
- 25m Sport Pistol
- 25m Standard Pistol
- 10m Women's Air Pistol
- 10m Men's Air Pistol

Minimum Qualifying Scores (MQS):

To be considered for the NZ Pistol Team, a shooter must be a current financial member of a Pistol NZ member club and shoot an appropriate MQS **twice** as follows:

Qualification Period:

Qualifying matches:

There will be up to 10 matches used for selection, including up to three pre approved international competitions and seven national competitions

National:

March	2009	PNZ ISSF Nationals (compulsory) (Hamilton)

September	2009	Northland Open and Graded (Whangarei)

International:

April	2009	PA Nationals (Cessnock)
July	2009	Australian Shooting Games (Brisbane)
August	2009	AIISL Australia Cup 2 (Sydney)

Overseas based competitors:

Overseas based shooters who wish to contest selection may substitute events for ranking and MQS providing that the events are on equal or higher standard and that they are nominated prior to taking place. The PNZ Nationals are still compulsory and attendance is required.

Selection Process:

The **PNZ ISSF Nationals are compulsory** for selection purposes, giving a total of three scores from the ten matches.

- a/ The three highest ranked shooters **for each match** who have met the selection criteria will be selected as the New Zealand Team, should a "A" team be selected

Ratification of Selected Teams:

- a/ The Selectors for the PNZ ISSF Oceania Team are the Section Director, the ISSF Coach and the PNZ President. Selectors will "stand down" on selecting any team members that they the Selectors maybe eligible for.
- b/ Teams will be confirmed at the conclusion of the 2009 Northland Championships.
- c/ Successful team members will be advised once teams have been ratified by PNZ council. The list of successful Team Members will also be sent to the NZSF
- d/ Vacant team positions can be filled from the Commonwealth Federation Championships Ranking list in order, subject to having secured the appropriate MQS scores.
- e/ If only 2 athletes are available , then the third slot , maybe filled by the top junior, on the ranking list, if that junior has secured one MQS
- f/ All selected shooters must sign the Athlete's Agreement and any appeals are forwarded to the PNZ selectors. (NZSF or PNZ).
