2010 World Championships Ranking list Matches

Seniors - To attend the World Shooting Championships, the athlete must finish in the top 3 places in Air Pistol and top two positions in all other disciplines with the required MQS's on the World Championships ranking List. The athletes do not have to be a member of the A or B squad but **MUST** have one MQS score from the World Championships ranking list matches to be eligible for selection.

The ranking list will be the 2 highest scores plus a compulsory score from the NZ Nationals. The Commonwealth Federation Championships can substitute the Shooters of Auckland match in Hamilton if the athlete attends this match.

Juniors - To attend the World Shooting Championships, the athlete must finish in the top 2 places in Air Pistol and top position in all other disciplines with the required MQS's on the World Championships ranking List. The athlete **MUST** have one MQS scores from the World Championships ranking list matches to be eligible for selection.

The ranking list will be the 2 highest scores plus a compulsory score from the NZ Nationals.

To break any deadlock for the three top/ top two and top places in both seniors and juniors, it will be broken at the NZ Nationals where the tie will be broken by ISSF rules.

Athletes must confirm with NZSF or PNZ ISSF Director before matches if they are using a substitution. If not then the first score will be the counted score.

Information specific for Pistol NZ (World Championships 2010)

Ratification of Selected Teams:

- a/ The PNZ ISSF Representative/PNZ President and NZSF representative will ratify the top three ranked shooters for the World Championships team. They will “stand down” on selecting any team members that they are eligible for.
- b/ Team will be confirmed after the conclusion of the New Zealand Nationals in 2010
- c/ Successful team members will be advised once teams have been ratified by PNZ. The list of successful Team Members will also be sent to the NZSF.
- d/ Vacant team positions can be filled firstly from the World Championships Ranking list in order, subject to having secured the appropriate MQS scores, then vacant positions filled by 2010 Commonwealth Games Team.
- e/ All selected shooters must sign the Athlete’s Agreement
