



## Election of Section Director Speed Section Nominations Close 16th March



The process of identifying a Section Director for the Speed Section (and all sections) now relies on the participation of the shooters who are involved with the discipline, by way of an election.

### Process:

- The XO is to call for nominations 8 WEEKS prior to the Nationals. **(Nomination forms to be placed on the PNZ Website).**
- Candidates must put forward their nominations and a brief Bio 4 WEEKS prior to the Nationals – no late nominations accepted
- Postal (e-votes etc) votes to be with XO FOURTEEN DAYS (last date 30<sup>th</sup> March) prior to the Nationals, can be made after the nominees are posted on the PNZ website.
- If required, a returning Officer will be appointed by the XO and will be given the postal list and they are to delete any postals where the competitor attends the match.
- Voting on the first day of the match, voting slips to be given out at registration (supplied by Pistol NZ, these will also be online once the nominations close)
- Voting slips (at the match) are to be in the returning box by 5.00 PM.
- After voting closes the Returning Officer can announce the results and supply the result to the XO.
- XO to advise Council of the results, which will be placed on the PNZ website.
- Anyone who is a financial member of PNZ can vote.

If there are no nominations (by the nominations closing date) or the SD does not complete the full term (2 years) The PNZ Council will appoint an interim SD.  
In the event that only one nomination is received by the closing date, that person will be declared the new Section Director (after council approval).

- Nominations are now called for the following position: **Speed NZ Section Director**
- Nominations close on the **16th March 2012**
- All nominations must be in writing on the approved nomination form.
- Forms will be available on the PNZ website (or from the XO if required).
- No nominations will be accepted without the signature of the person being nominated
- The Section Director roles and duties can also be found on the PNZ Speed page.

## **PNZ SECTION DIRECTOR RESPONSIBILITIES**

### **1. Purpose of Role:**

- To assist with the promotion of the discipline and promotion of competitions at all levels.
- To conduct the affairs of the Section, in a dignified and orderly manner.

### **2. The role and responsibility of the Section Director:**

- The Section Director will, at all times, be held responsible to Pistol New Zealand for the operation and functioning of the Section.
- At no time will the responsibility for the administration of the funds of the Section be devolved to a Section Committee
- On all matters, as the elected representative, the Section Director shall have the final say in all matters for which he is held liable.
- Section Director shall at all times be responsible to the Pistol New Zealand Council, through the Pistol New Zealand Executive Officer.
- Liaison with International Team Manager
- Management of the PNZ Section team budget
- Maintaining expenditure within allocated budget
- Maintaining International affiliations
- The establishment of a Section Committee with regional representation
- Liaison with the Range Development Sub Committee (Recommended)
- Liaison with the PNZ Safety Committee to maintain up to date club and National qualifications exams and other safety programmes.
- Ensuring that minutes from all Section committee meetings are recorded and circulated to the sub committee members with a copy attached to the Section Director's report to the Executive Officer of Pistol New Zealand
- Administer Section Trust Funds, with accountability for same, to Pistol New Zealand.
- Set and administer a Section Team selection policy that is in step with the Pistol New Zealand selection policy, in a timely manner for all PNZ selected teams.
- Presentation of reports to Pistol New Zealand Selector/s and of all Section International Team results and performances.
- Maintain section grading records (where appropriate)
- Encourage clubs to host National, Island and Regional Championships.
- Provide support for all members, at all levels of the sport.

### **3. Section Director Position Requirements:**

- Liaison with the Executive Officer on all matters relating to the administration and effective running of the section.
- Liaison with the Competitions sub-committee Convenor (PNZ Executive Officer) on all discipline events for promotion and publication.
- Production of a report on Section activities for each Pistol New Zealand Council meeting.

- Copies of all inward and outward correspondence on matters concerning Pistol New Zealand Policy and International affiliations to be sent to the Executive Officer for filing. (E-mail).
- To attend all National and Island competitions for their section, or arrange a delegate to attend.
- Maintain a Section selection dossier on all prospective NZ representatives.
- Organise training as appropriate to the Section.
- Organise coaching as appropriate for squad and team members.
- Provide advice to clubs wishing to hold National or Island competitions on standards to be met.
- Production of a report for each issue of Bullshooter
- Advice to competitions Convenor (PNZ XO) of planned events.
- Provide access by members to current competition rules
- Encourage Section members to attain Range Officer qualifications
- Programme Team selection trials as and where necessary
- Maintain a register of selection trial results
- Maintain a register of Section trophies
- Maintain a register of NZ Records (these are posted on the PNZ website).
- Circulate a newsletter outlining section activities to member clubs on a regular basis. (Recommended).
