

# Pistol NZ 480 Action Match v1.0



Pistol NZ 480 Action Match is a shortened version of the Bianchi Cup courses of fire from the NRA Action Pistol Rulebook. One set of strings from each distance of the 4 aggregate events is shot, and except where specified below, all events are shot as per the latest NRA Action Pistol Rules, on the official target.

All courses of fire start with the handgun loaded, held in the 45 degree start position, and must be shot in the standing position. A freestyle two handed grip is allowed for all events, except for String 3 in Event One.

Either centre fire or rimfire handguns may be used, in either Open or Metallic Sights configuration. The match requires only 48 rounds, with 12 rounds being fired in each event. There is no power factor required for this event, but it is expected that the ammunition is the same through all four events.

Pistol NZ 480 Action Match will be shot at the Pistol NZ Action Pistol National Championships, with holster trained shooters not eligible to compete.

The match score is the aggregate of the 4 events listed below:

## **Event One - Practical Event - 10 Yards**

String 1: 1 shot on each target in 3 seconds

String 2: 2 shots on each target in 4 seconds

String 3: 3 shots on each target in 8 seconds with the weak hand only  
*(it is acceptable to start String 3 with the handgun held in the weak hand only)*

## **Event Two - Falling Plate Event - 15 Yards**

String 1: 1 shot on each plates in 7 seconds

String 2: 1 shot on each plates in 7 seconds

## **Event Three - Barricade Event - 25 Yards**

String 1: 6 shots at the right target from the right side of barricade in 7 seconds

String 2: 6 shots at the left target from the left side of barricade in 7 seconds  
*(it is acceptable to shoot String 1 and String 2 in reverse order)*

## **Event Four - Moving Target (Modified) Event - 15 Yards**

String 1: 6 shots at the target as it moves from right to left

String 2: 6 shots at the target as it moves from left to right
